## Certain Credentialed Speech-Language Pathologists No Longer Require Supervision

California's State Plan Amendment (SPA) 05-010, approved by the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), redefines the supervision requirements for certain credentialed speech-language pathologists participating in the CA LEA Billing Option Program.

The measure *removes* supervision requirements for speech-language pathologists who have:

- a Preliminary Services Credential in speech-language pathology;
- a Professional Clear Services Credential in speech-language pathology.

Speech-language pathologists who hold the older CTC Clinical or Rehabilitative Services Credential in Language, Speech, and Hearing *must continue to be supervised* by either an SLP with a clear Speech-Language Pathology license or the new CTC Professional Clear Services Credential in Speech-Language Pathology.

SPA 05-010, written in October 2009, was a joint venture between DHCS and the LEA Ad-Hoc Workgroup.
